

Parole Determination

Parole Granted

The NSW State Parole Authority has made a parole order for Donald Yuke.

Yuke was convicted of murder and sentenced to 24 years, expiring 28 March 2032 with a non-parole period of 14 years which expired 28 March 2022.

A parole review hearing today was advised the Serious Offenders Review Council is satisfied his release on supervised parole is now appropriate.

A Community Corrections pre-release report also supporting his release on parole, noted he has completed his program pathway in custody and referenced a detailed plan for his supervision and reintegration in the community.

The State made no submissions opposing parole.

The Authority ordered his release to parole not earlier than 2 April 2024 and not later than 8 April 2024.

On parole, he must comply with:

- Standard Conditions of parole 1-11 and
- Additional Conditions he:
 - Abstain from alcohol
 - Not use a prohibited drug or substance, except those that have been prescribed to him.
 - Participate in the following intervention, CSNSW Psychology
 - Comply with all direction of the mental health team including treatment and medication (and if applicable the conditions of a Community Treatment Order)
 - Not contact, communicate with, watch, stalk, harass or intimidate the victim's family

His parole order expires 28 March 2032 unless revoked.
